Erasmus Plus – Individual mobility in Campania

- Fund: ESF 2014–20 (axis 3, S.O. 14)
- Budget: 3.9 M euro
- Period: 3 years (2017–20)
- Beneficiaries: Campania Universities
- Objective: To finance the international mobility of students for study and internship paying particular attention to less well-off students

2 Actions

- **Integration of mobility grants and internships** approved under the Erasmus plus key action 1 programme, for deserving students who have certified a **lower income** through the presentation of the ISEE form – **200 euro**
- **Financing of students** who are **eligible** but **not beneficiaries** of transnational mobility grants and internships assigned under the Erasmus plus program key 1

Some considerations

Policies to support student internationalization vary greatly from university to university in terms of:

- Ability/willingness to **co-finance the programme**
- Ability/willingness to **expand the number of agreements** with partner Universities
- *the reporting procedures of European funds are perceived as more complex than those of National funds!*

Erasmus Startup in Campania Mobility grants

- Fund: ESF 2014-20
- Budget: 1,6 M euro
- Period: 3 years (2018-20)
- Beneficiaries: Startupper, spin-offs or aspiring entrepreneurs
- Objective: Support international exchange activities – from 1 to 6 months – to acquire experience abroad, at incubators, accelerators, international academies and other startup businesses supporting organizations

- The intervention is complementary to the EC "Erasmus for young entrepreneurs" programme
- The amount of funding for each **individual scholarship** is made up of the contribution for the costs for **mobility** (travel and accommodation) and for any **services** provided by the company support structures
- The maximum limits are set in analogy with the provisions of the European Commission
- *Consideration: Individual VS Institutional organization*

Co-financing of the research period abroad of innovative PhD scholarships (*Ministerial Decree 117/23 A.Y. 2023/2024*)

- Fund: ESF+ 2021–27 (Priority 2, S.O. 4.7)
- Budget: 14,5 M euro
- Period: 2 years (2023–25)
- Beneficiaries: Campania Universities
- Objective: To support the promotion of higher education and post-graduate specialization at doctoral level, in order to contribute to the development of an economy based on knowledge and innovation

A **Public-private synergy** with 3 partners involved:

- Ministry of the University + Private companies cover the costs of the scholarship for the national component
- Campania Region supports the international component, by covering the supplementary cost of doctoral scholarships, for periods of study and research carried out abroad (from 6 to 18 months)
- *The call for proposal is ongoing: deadline 20/11/2024*

Other synergies

- Seal of Excellence (Startup – Tech Transfer projects)
- Clean Sky 2/Clean Aviation JU (R&D projects)
