Erasmus+ / Next Generation EU synergy: Legal Basis

Standing on NRRF budget, the Ministerial Decree No. 61 of 3 April 2023 of the Ministry of Public Education allocated up to **€ 150 million** of NRRP funds to **INDIRE** National Agency for the **period 2023–2025** to foster exchanges and mobility activities not funded by the Erasmus+, through the **Mission 4 – Component 1 – Investment 3.1 “New Skills and New Languages”**.

INDIRE Implementing body

INDIRE, as **Implementing Body**, INDIRE's main tasks include, among others:

- **selection** of the "Implementing Entities" involved in the project (beneficiary schools);
- **implementation** of the intervention in agreement with the Ministry, ensuring the timely start of activities;
- **monitoring** comply with monitoring requirements on the physical, financial, and procedural progress of the intervention and the achievement of associated targets;
- **ensuring the traceability** of operations with adequate accounting codification and **legal** checks;
- **communication** comply with communication obligations concerning the support of European funds by including references to European funding in project documentation.

Executing bodies

The **Executing bodies**, including the beneficiary schools and the economic operators involved in the intervention, are responsible for its on-the-ground execution.

Their responsibilities include:

- 📍 **data collection and transfer;**
- 📍 **administrative and accounting controls;**
- 📍 **compliance** with PNRR conditionalities.

- Short-term (30 days) group mobilities

The objectives

2. Enhancing the advisory and information programmes linked to Erasmus+

Advisory and Information activities with **Regions and Provinces**, through the involvement of **Ambassadors, Alumni and Role Models**, to **stimulate the participation** of an increasing number of **individuals and institutions**

To ensure a better management and monitoring of the implementation of activities, and to **ensure coherence** with the **Erasmus and eTwinning** promotion/dissemination activities in schools

3 Work Packages (WP)

- WP1 Mobility
- WP2 Monitoring & Control
- WP3 Mentoring on Erasmus+

WPI mobility (Call 2023 and 2024)

Giving access to international mobilities to students and school staff which applied for previous Erasmus+ KA121/122 calls, but did not receive the grant (have not left).

Activities:

- 📍 **1.1 – Mobility of KA121 applicants (who received KA120 accreditation)**
- 📍 **1.2 – Mobility of KA122 applicants (who are in the reserve list for lack of funds)**

Targets

The project started in **September 2024**.

Within 2025, the synergy foreseen an additional funding for 27.000 people among students and school staff for the call 2023 and 2024.

WP2 Monitoring & Control

Coordination, monitoring and control over the streams of activity must be applied to ensure compliance with NRPP rules.

Activities:

- ♦ **2.1 – Development and implementation of an online platform for monitoring, data storage and data sharing, management and traceability of activities and docs**
- ♦ **2.2 – Platform Help Desk & stakeholders tutoring activity**

WP3 Mentoring/consulting on Erasmus+

Ambassadors, Alumni and Role Models play a pivotal role in **consulting** and **informing** schools, students, institutions and the public on Erasmus+ mobility opportunities.

The aim of the WP is to ensure the enlargement of the network, with a particular care for Erasmus+ newcomers.

Activities:

📍 **3.1 – Involvement of regions, provinces and local stakeholders**

NEW 📍 **3.2 – Support to schools: dissemination of opportunities and best practices, and data analysis from Erasmus+ and eTwinning actions**
