



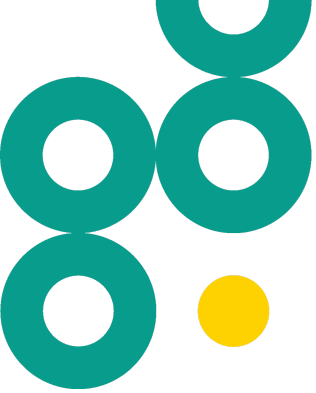

**Missions:** raise awareness, train and equip NAs and beneficiaries, identify and develop measurement and analysis tools, give visibility to good practices.

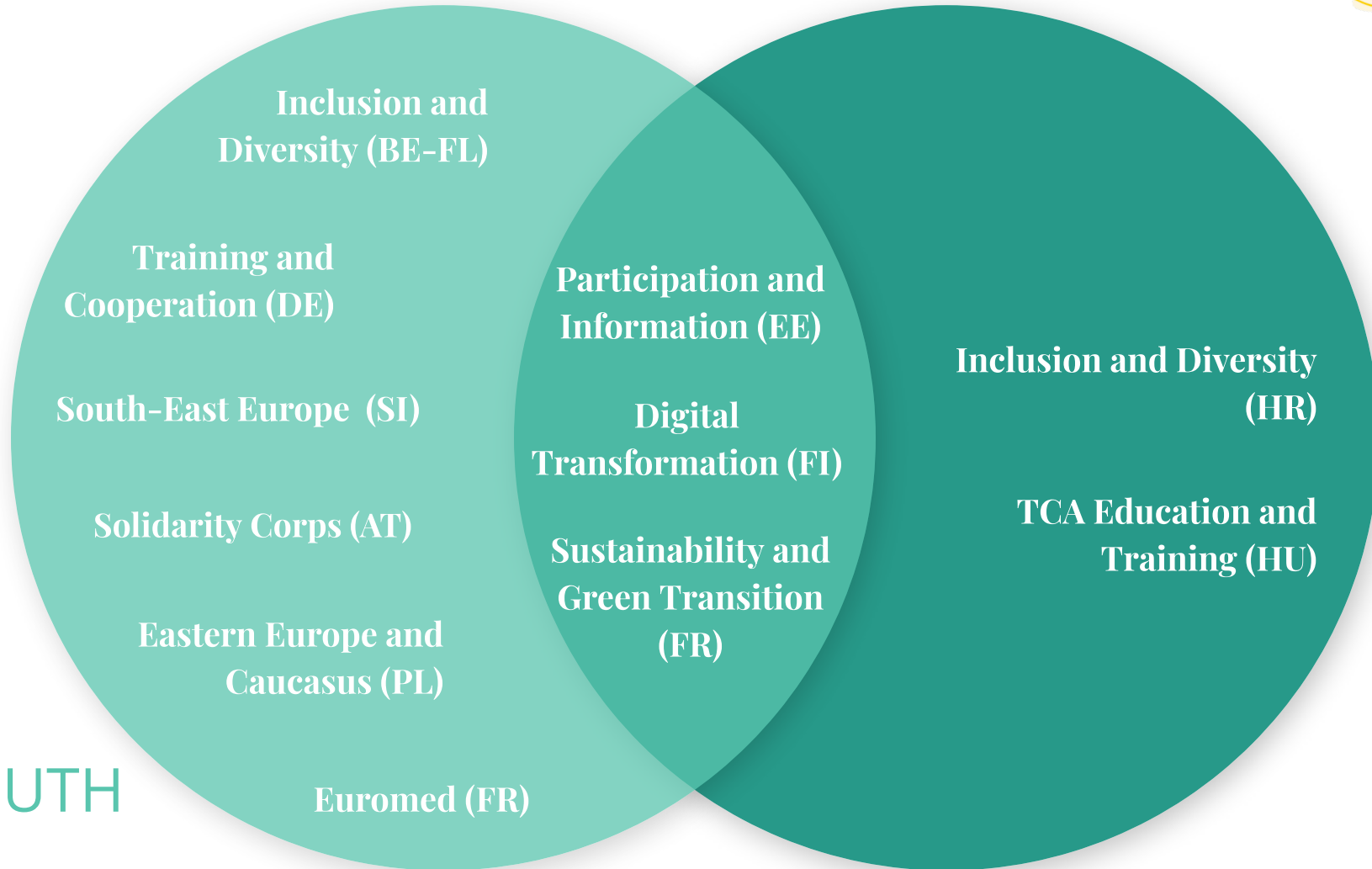
**Limit the footprint:** transitioning the Programmes toward carbon-neutrality, and lowering it's harmful environmental impact.

### Call for tender

Study on the environmental impact of the Erasmus+ programme and the obstacles to green mobility



- Launched in 2026
- Results by the end of 2026 - January 2027
- 6 National agencies co-funding (HR, FI, DE, LT, LU and RO)
- Consultative partners (other NAs, organisations, experts)
- Qualitative and quantitative surveys in all sectors

# Funding rules

Green Travel: bike, train, bus, shared car.

The duration of the stay includes up to four additional days for participants, for trainers, facilitators and accompanying person receiving a green travel grant.

**2026, Erasmus+ added ferries to green travel if you combine it with other green transportation**

For travel distances between...	Green Travel	non Green Travel
10 and 99 KM	56 €	28 €
100 and 499 KM	285 €	211 €
500 and 1 999 KM	417 €	309 €
2 000 and 2 999 KM	535 €	395 €
3 000 and 3 999 KM	785 €	580 €
4 000 and 7 999 KM	1 188 €	1 188 €
8 000 KM or more	1 735 €	1 735 €



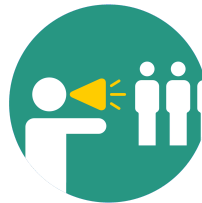

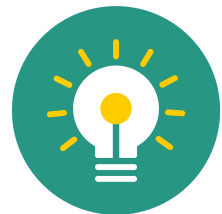

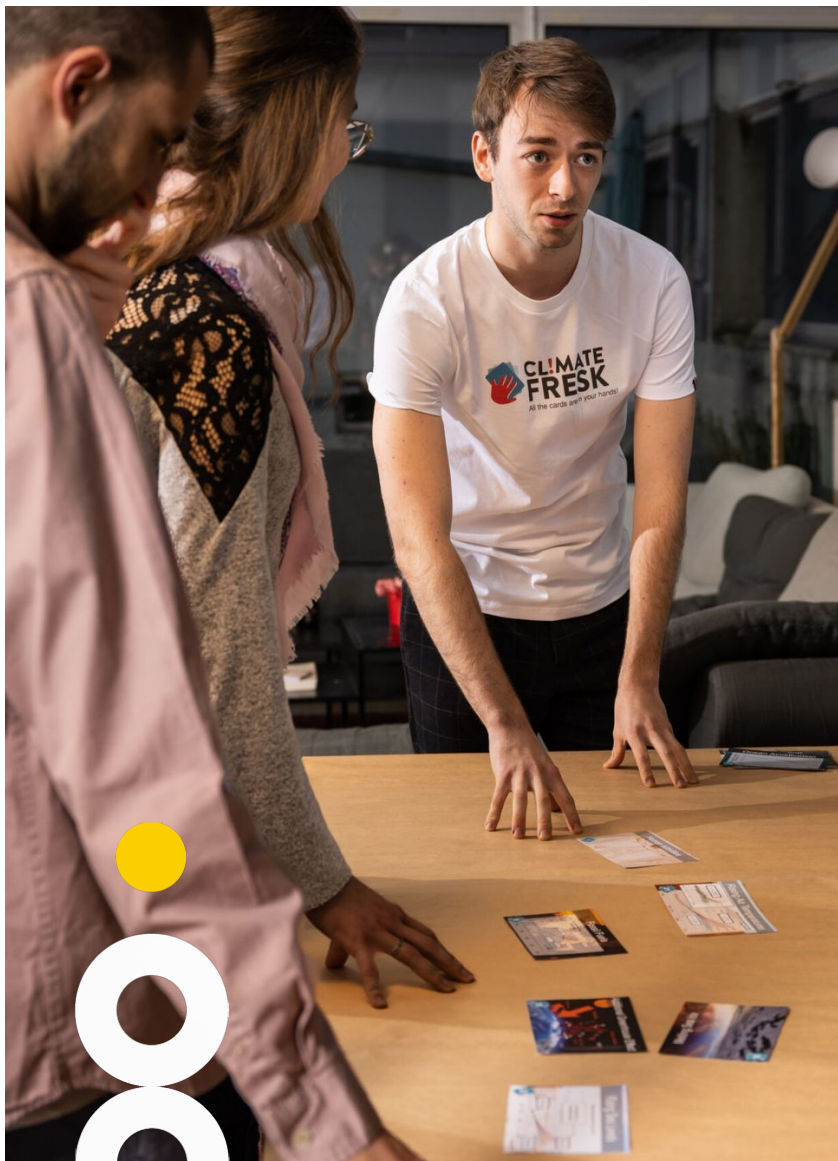
## IMPLEMENTING ECOLOGY AMONG STUDENTS IN HIGHER EDUCATION

Every year, Students Weeks for Ecology and Solidarity celebrate various initiatives to gather students and actors acting for more sustainable societies and campuses. Usually held from 11 March to 14 April.

At **SALTO Green**, our mission is to **highlight and promote green initiatives**—especially in higher education, where students and institutions are driving inspiring change through **ecology and Erasmus+ projects**.

We present a collection of higher education European Alliances, projects and resources related to green transition.



## Climate Fresk

- 1 200 000 participants, 60 000 animateurs, in 50 pays and more 40 languages.
- A collaborative learning workshop to discover the mechanisms of climate change.

## 2 Tonnes

- 4 000 facilitators trained 60 000 persons in 25 countries.
- A roleplaying experience where participants try to lower their collective and individual carbon footprints.
